Getting to the Museum & Tickets

Museum address - American Museum of Natural History, 200 Central Park West, New York, NY 10024

Public Transportation

Subway: Take the B (weekdays only) or C to 81st Street. Two blocks west of the Museum, the 1 train stops at Broadway and West 79th Street. For a complete subway map, <u>visit the MTA website</u>. Groups arriving by subway may enter via the Subway entrance, located at the downtown end of the 81st Street B and C station.

Please note: The 81st Street subway station and subway entrance to the Museum are not wheelchair accessible. The closest accessible subway station is the 72nd Street station for the 1, 2, and 3 trains, with a connection on the northbound M7 on Amsterdam Avenue.

Bus: The M79 bus travels east/west on West 79th Street across Central Park, with a stop next to the Museum on West 81st Street. Other buses also stop at or near the Museum, including the M7, M10, M11, M86, and M104 buses. For complete bus information, visit the MTA website.

From Hunter - take 6 uptown to 77th st (or walk), then take M79 (on 79th st & Lexington) crosstown to the Columbus Av/W 80 St Stop
